<p>Poster Topic: Seeking submissions about quality improvement in patient care and education</p>	<p>A few questions to consider as you design your poster presentations:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. How have you improved patient care or made it safer? 2. Have you improved trainee education? If so, how? 3. We encourage collaboration between health professions and/or departments and the involvement of trainees.
<p>Poster Criteria & Judging Process</p>	<p>Electronic poster submissions (see submission process below) will be reviewed and judged based on the criteria below. All poster submissions will be displayed during the event. Finalists will be selected and asked to present their posters on the day of the event in Cox Hall on the Emory University Campus, where their posters will be judged and winners announced. Posters not selected as finalists will be shown at other sites to be communicated to you closer to the event.</p> <p>Poster judging criteria:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Clarity of hypothesis or improvement aim 2. Appropriateness of methods 3. Clarity of data display 4. Relevance and importance of the conclusions 5. Inclusion of trainees 6. Demonstration of interprofessional teamwork
